Actions in the Liturgy

You might think about a radical revision of the Liturgy starting in another place until the Gospel, using the Palm Gospel as the Eucharist Gospel and using the Passion Gospel after Communion

- ❖ **Ministry of the Word leading to Palm Gospel**
- ❖ **Procession with Palms Donkey etc**
- ❖ **Intercessions**
- ❖ **Peace**
- ❖ **Ministry of the Sacrament**
- ❖ **Passion Gospel**
- ❖ **Blessing and Dismissal**
