Wakefield Diocesan Lent Course 2006

A special invitation to get together for a spiritual journey during Lent 2006 is being sent to Christians in the Diocese of Wakefield. They are being asked to take part in a 'Spiritual Pilgrimage' in the form of a new Lent course called 'Everyday God'. The course in Christian discipleship has been specially prepared to help participants to deepen their Faith and enrich their life. 'Everyday God' has been designed to provide something for everyone, everyday, during

Lent, with Bible notes, prayers and ideas for alternative services for all ages. The Archdeacon of Pontefract, Jonathan Greener, said the Course was a great opportunity for everyone in the Diocese to take a new and exciting spiritual journey together. "I'm praying that thousands of pilgrims will come along and grasp the chance to deepen their Faith in everyday situations," he said. 'Pilgrims' who go on this spiritual journey will also have the chance to hear two famous speakers – writer Angela Ashwin and The Revd Dr Gavin Ashenden, Sussex University Chaplain. Angela will focus on 'Deepening our prayer life' and Dr Ashenden on 'Living out our Faith day by day.' During weeks two and four of Lent the guest speakers will travel to different venues around the Diocese to speak/lead a session which will be an integral part of the course. Training evenings for group leaders and clergy will be held in November.
