

Clergy sickness

A time of illness can be difficult and distressing. Priests and their families who are ill for more than a few days should contact their Rural Dean to let him/her know about the situation, so that practical support and prayer can be offered.

When clergy are ill for more than seven days a doctor's medical certificate will be required, and clergy are requested to complete the Inland Revenue's standard self-assessment form SC2. This can be downloaded and printed from www.cofe.anglican.org/info/clergypay/sc02, or is available from the diocesan office.
