

The Children and Youth Leader Pathway

What is it?

A course based on the National Core Competencies for the Bishop's Certificate for Youth Leaders and the General Synod Child in the Midst Report, it creates an opportunity for those who work with children and young people to explore and develop their experience and skills.

How long is the course?

There are nine modules in total which are completed over a maximum period of 3 years—the pathway can be completed over a shorter time if preferred. Each module will consist of teaching/input on either a Saturday or a couple of evenings.

What topics are covered?

Induction
The Context of Working with children and young people
Child Protection
Good Practice
The Bible
Evangelism
Ways of Working
Working Outside the Church

Is there any assessment?

For those wishing to complete the Bishop's Certificate in Youth Work, assessment is made of a portfolio, which is completed during the course—this is not compulsory for attendees.

How much does it cost?
