

Worshipping the Creator

“An interactive worship experience that enables participants to encounter God through reflecting on his creation and gaining a fresh sense of awe and wonder.”

- It's an installation, not a service—participants engage with it at their own pace.
- There are seven stations set up in a circle with an eighth station in the middle.
- Participants are given a written guide and portable CD player with headphones. They listen to spoken meditations over music, and, directed by the written guide and words at the stations, they interact with the materials, thinking about how they make their mark on creation and applying what they have heard to their own lives.

A basic kit, including 6 CD's and portable CD players, participants guides, station instructions, posters for the stations, table covers and some of the materials for each station, can be borrowed from Wakefield Resource Centre from **5th June**.

Bookings should be pre-arranged with Resource Centre staff and a £5 donation to cover replacement of tea-lights, modelling clay etc would be appreciated when the resource is returned.
