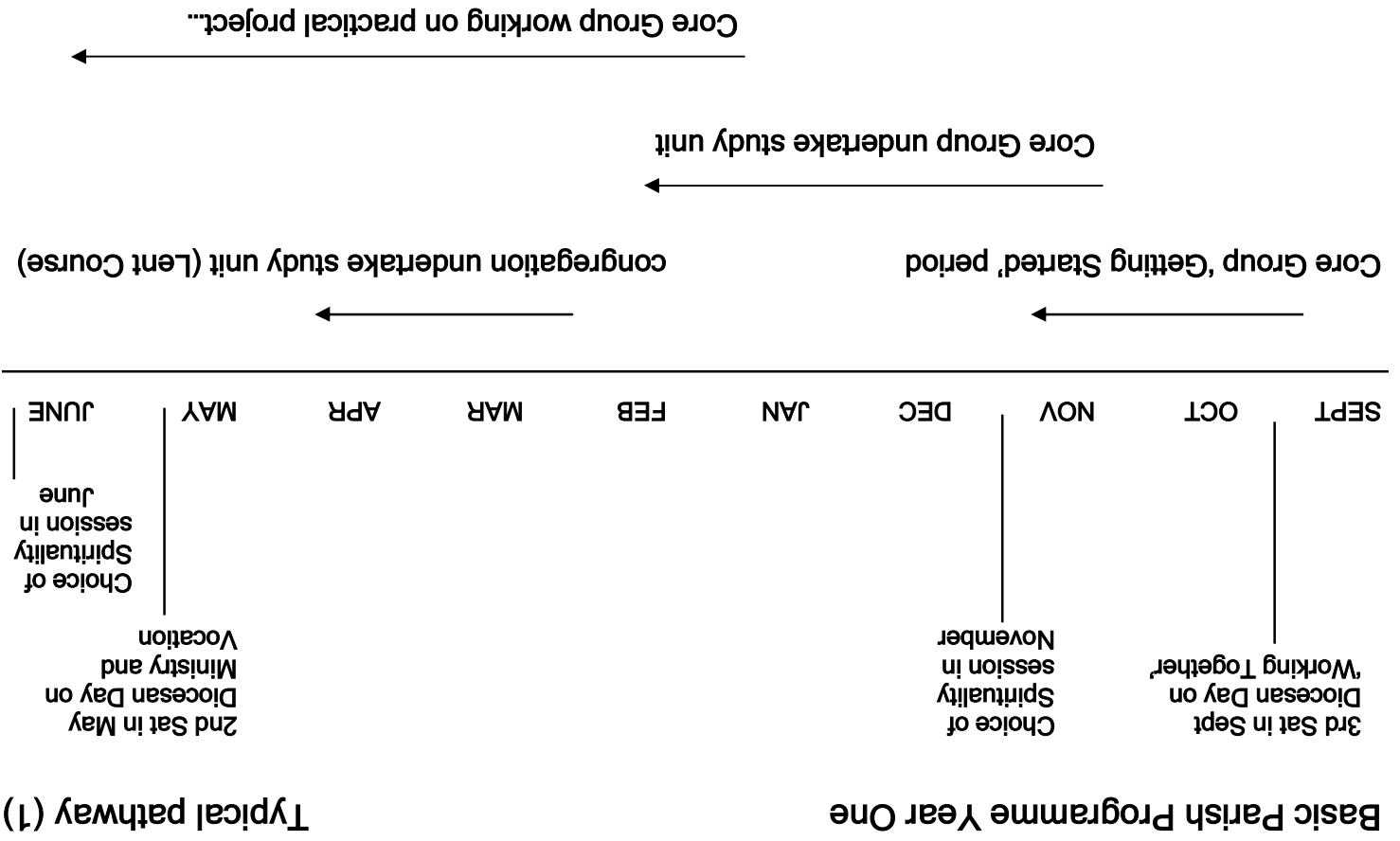


(This is the nearest to the 'typical' pathway, using Lent as a congregational study time.)

The Basic Parish Programme Typical Pathways for Parishes

Year One

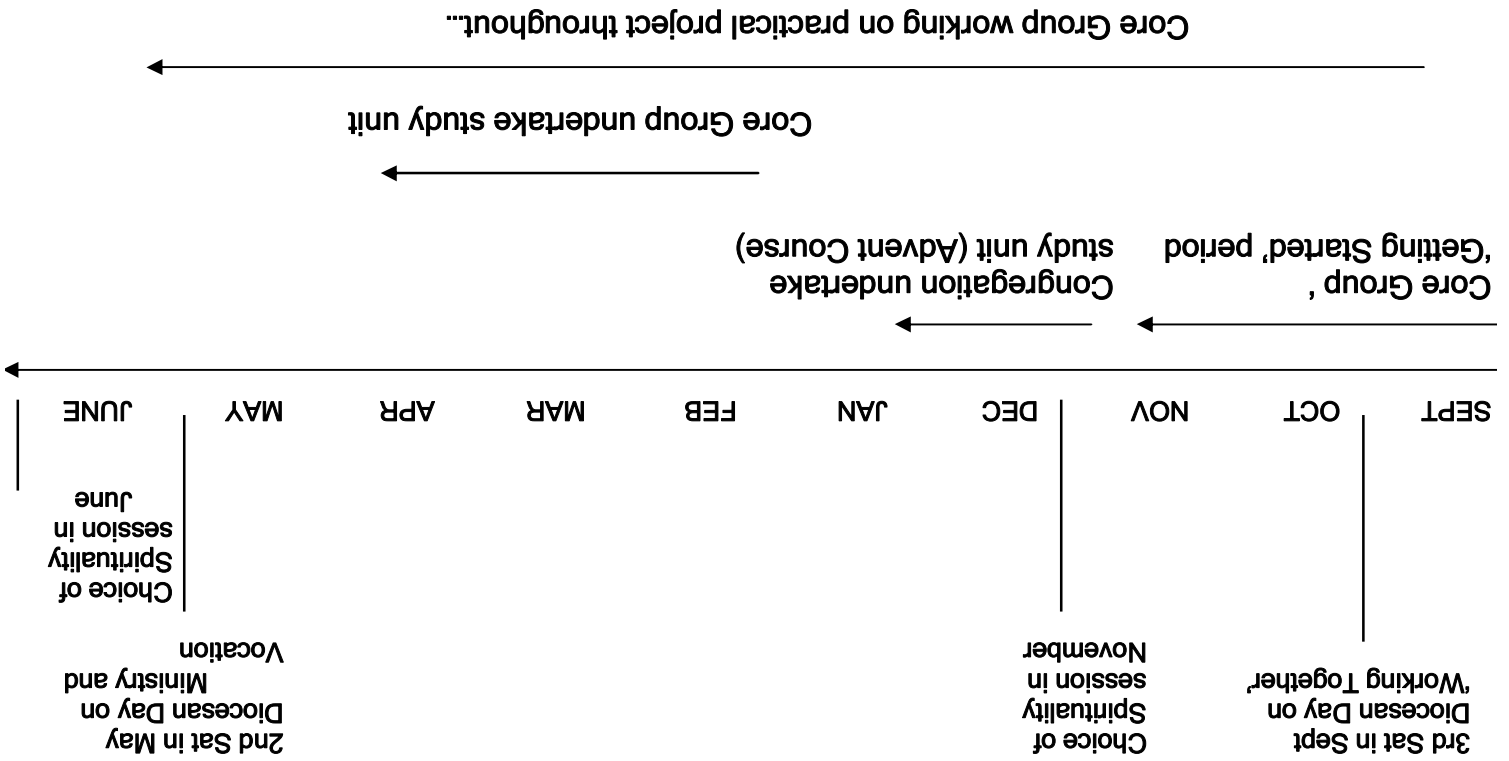
The primary aim of Year One of the Basic Parish Programme is the establishment of an effective Core Group to promote and model a collaborative style of ministry for the whole church.

To resource this the diocesan topics for the year are Working Together and Exploring Ministry and Vocation, the subjects of the two Diocesan Days in September and May.

During the year Core Groups are asked to undertake a study course for themselves, to work on a practical project such as a parish audit, and to organise a study course open to the congregation.

This leaflet contains three examples of ways in which this programme might be put together.

(This alternative pathway could suit Core Groups wishing to get into more practical and congregational activities before proceeding to their own study.)

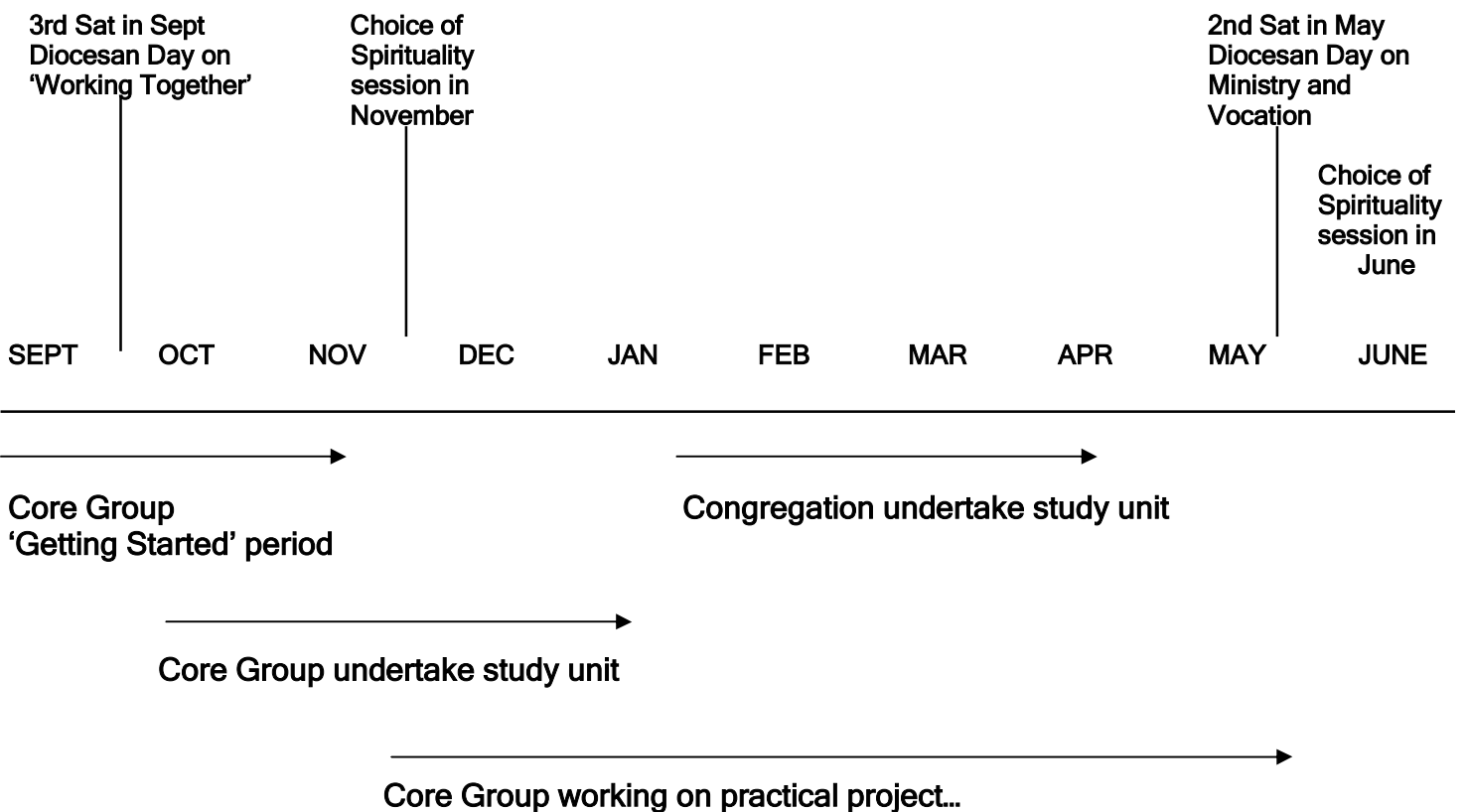


Basic Parish Programme Year One
