Fraser Teal Renaissance Bursary Awards



Over the past five years the Renaissance agenda has gone from strength to strength. Yorkshire Forward wants to celebrate this achievement and the work of key individuals who have worked tirelessly to contribute to the growth of Renaissance within the Region. And so in memory of the late Fraser Teal, a Renaissance professional who worked within the region, we have assembled 3 awards.

There will be three £15,000 bursary awards made to 3 individuals. One each from a town, a market town and city. The Bursary will be awarded to 3 champions of the Renaissance in their area. The award is designed to enable them to develop their skills, knowledge and abilities within the Renaissance agenda.

Criteria for Entry

- The awards are open to any age group (Under 18's will require a supervisor)
- The entrant must live or be based through their work in Yorkshire and Humber
- The entrant must be involved in the renaissance of a market town, town or city
- It is open to any professional or non-professional – i.e. volunteer, student, architect, teacher, local authority employee including CEO
- The applicant will require 3 sponsors to support their application
- Activities covered by the bursary will cover formal education (e.g. studying economics, architecture, urban design, community engagement etc), practical experience (e.g. working with an international professional as an unpaid apprentice - for example working with Rem Koolhaas in the Netherlands, or volunteering work with a Non-Governmental Organisation to gain community development experience).

Application

- All applications will be made online on the Yorkshire Forward website
- The applicant will supply a 3000 word dossier of activities and contributions to the Renaissance of their area
- The applicant will also supply a 500 word proposal as to how they propose to use the Bursary to progress the region.



Time Scale

Applications can be made online from the 1st July 2006.

The closing date for entries is the 31st October 2006.

The awards will be made in February 2007.
